

Procedure for Public Comment at Oklahoma Virtual Charter Academy Board Meetings that are held virtually:

Call to the public

This is the time for the public to comment. Members of the Governing Board may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda. Therefore, action taken as a result of public comment will be limited to directing school staff to study the matter, respond to any criticism, or schedule the matter for further consideration and decision at a later date.

Procedure to sign up for public comment during the virtual meeting:

Requests to comment can be heard using the “chat” feature within the Zoom video conference. Public Comments are limited to three (3) minutes and must be related to an agenda item or topic. Where several people wish to address the same subject, a spokesperson must be selected. The Board Chairman may interrupt and terminate any comments that are not in accordance with any of these criteria. Board members may not respond to speakers’ comments. If you would like to comment please put your name, date and public comment request in the chat once you enter the Zoom video conference.
